What is workplace giving?

Workplace giving is one of the easiest ways for organisations to support not for profit organisations and show good corporate social responsibility. It allows your employees to donate a nominated sum directly to a charity of their choice from their salary each pay cycle pre-tax.

Why set up workplace giving at our workplace?
